Highways & PROWs 02/24/06

a) To consider the condition of Cut Road

The Council received an update that included:

- The land is unregistered and no legal owner can be pinpointed.
- County Councillor Grogan is liaising with Highways at NYC to see if a meeting can be arranged with all the parties requiring access over the land
- Residents have raised concerns about access and issues getting across with pushchairs and mobility aids.
- Concerns that when high voltage cable was installed at the location 2/3 years ago, the contractor filled the gully on the right hand side causing additional

RESOLUTION: Parish Clerk to contact Cllr Grogan to obtain an update on meeting arrangements.

Parish Clerk to contact Highways dept to report the concerns about gully removal.
